

2013 4-H Horse Camp Rules and Safety Guidelines



June 23- June 27, 2013

1. No flip flops, slippers or sandals in the barn – adults included!!
2. No dogs in the barn. Dogs must be on leash at safe distance from horses.
3. Do not **ride** horses on the blacktop.
4. No horses on the concrete aisle in the barn.
5. Lead your horse to and from all classes.
6. SEI approved headgear must be worn for all mounted classes.
7. No bareback, racing, or riding double.
8. Never walk directly behind any horse. Keep a safe distance!
9. No stall guards on stall doors. No hay nets in stalls.
10. All horses must be fed between 6:30-8:00 a.m., 11:30-12:30 p.m., and 6:30-7:30 p.m.
11. Water must be kept in the stalls at all times. Two buckets are recommended.
12. Stalls must be kept clean. Bring appropriate cleaning equipment (pitchfork & muck bucket).
- 11. Stalls must be cleaned and checked before leaving on Thursday.**
12. Be courteous and follow the instructions of your instructor.
13. Be a good sport, be courteous and respectful to fellow campers.
14. Any problems or concerns contact a CIT, camp director or any adult.
15. All campers inside campers/tents at 11:00 p.m. Wake up time is 6:30 a.m.
16. No smoking, alcoholic beverages or unprescribed drugs allowed on premises.
17. Any required prescription and nonprescription medications shall be secured by camp staff unless prior arrangements are made with director(s).
18. All 4-H rules apply at horse camp. Any one offending these rules will be asked to leave camp immediately!
19. Please do not bring valuable items to camp. 4-H will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.
20. Remember that you are at camp – visitors are not allowed!
21. A negative Coggins test will be required for all horses brought to camp.
